

Management Services Prescribed Burning

Applied Ecological Services provides all natural area management services required in the Midwest including invasive species removal, mowing, brushing, herbicide application, and prescribed burning.

Burn crews are typically made up of three highly trained members and a burn boss with a minimum five years experience and S190/290 certification. AES requires the use of proper safety gear including Nomex suits, leather boots, gloves, eye protection, radios, and head gear. All proper equipment are supplied including backpack pump, flappers, drip torches, and rakes. A truck mounted water pump and an ATV mounted unit are typically deployed as well.

AES will provide permitting and notification services as required by the client to ensure that all regulations and requirements are met.
